## WHO SHOULD GET SCREENED?

Tobacco and alcohol users are at the greatest risk for these cancers. However, tonsil and tongue cancer is on the rise in younger adults who do not smoke, and recent research indicates this development is due partly to the increase of the human papillomavirus (HPV) virus, a cancer-causing infection that can be transmitted by oral sex.
